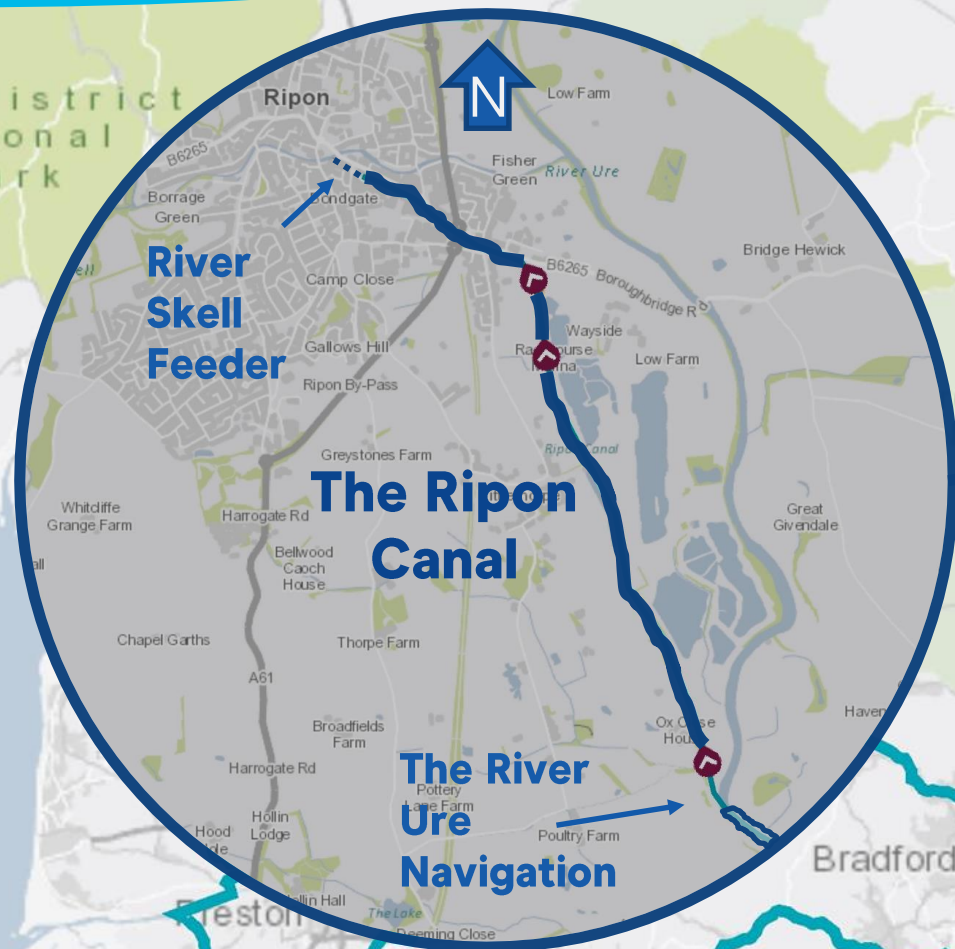


Where does the water come from?



All the water in the Ripon Canal comes from the River Skell, a tributary of the River Ure

The water flows through a sluice and 170 metres of pipeline under the town to the head of the canal

We control the amount of water taken from the River Skell, to maintain the ecology of the river

The Ripon Canal



The Ripon Canal was built to transport raw materials, including coal, and goods to and from Ripon

The Ripon Canal connects to the River Ure and River Ouse Navigations, and then to the canal network
