

## Where does the water come from?

Water supply to the Rochdale Nine, in Manchester, comes from several sources, all east of Manchester

The main water supply is from Hollingworth Lake Reservoir, owned by United Utilities PLC

Water can also be supplied from the adjoining Ashton Canal...

...which is in turn supplied from the Peak Forest Canal and Huddersfield Narrow Canal ...

....which are supplied by reservoirs on the edge of the Peak District

Bridgewater Canal, which gets its water from the Rochdale Canal

Rochdale Nine

Lock 90 Albion Mill & Lock 91 Deansgate on the 31 mile long Rochdale Canal form part of a series of locks (84 – 92) known locally as the Rochdale Nine



It takes 248,000 litres of water to fill Deansgate lock. Albion Mill is slightly smaller

These locks are filled and emptied over 500 times a year
