

Where does the water come from?

The twelve locks at Bosley lie at the centre of the Macclesfield Canal.

The water here comes from reservoirs on the edge of the Peak District. Bosley Reservoir feeds in just above the locks, and Sutton Reservoir 2 miles further north.

The water above these locks forms a continuous pound with the Peak Forest Canal, fed by Combs and Toddbrook reservoirs.
