The flight of 29 Locks at Caen Hill, Devizes, is on the west side of the Kennet and Avon Canal. Because there are no large water sources on this side of the canal. water is pumped into the canal from the Bristol Avon at Claverton, 13 miles away, and then pumped up around each flight of locks


The electricity for all the pumps lifting the water between the River Avon and Caen Hill Top Lock costs around £250,000 a year.
